



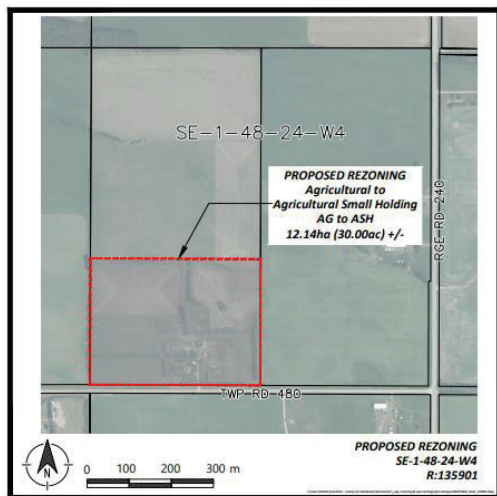

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 has received an application to amend its Land Use By-Law by rezoning part of the following lands, SE-1-48-24-W4M, as shown on the accompanying map, from Agricultural District (AG) to Agricultural Small Holdings District (ASH). A copy of the Agricultural Small Holdings District (ASH) outlining permitted and discretionary uses can be obtained from the County Office or by emailing wpermits@county10.ca.



Before proceeding further with the proposal, Council will hold a Public Hearing at which any person claiming to be affected by the proposed rezoning may ask questions or make their views known. As per the Municipal Government Act, any person affected has the right to petition this proposal. **The hearing will be held in the Council Chambers, County Office, 2.4 kilometres west of Wetaskiwin on Highway 13, at 9:15 a.m., Tuesday, May 17, 2022.**

In accordance with the Municipal Government Act, members of the public

have the right to attend the meetings in person. However, communication can be through alternative methods such as email, mailed correspondence, fax, or otherwise, rather than public attending the meeting in person. This will ensure that the information is presented to Council at or before the meeting and will also ensure the health and safety of all members of the public and County Staff.
